## Meeting the needs of EAL learners in your classroom (Primary/Secondary)



This one-year course is intended for teachers who lead on EAL in their school, and for class and subject teachers and teaching assistants working with EAL learners. It may also be useful as a refresher course on EAL and an opportunity to share good practice between primary or secondary schools.

The course will enable the participants to:

- Plan for increased attainment of EAL learners in the classroom
- Develop understanding of the distinctive needs of EAL learners
- Learn key EAL strategies and how to implement them in everyday learning
- Work effectively with new arrival EAL learners in the classroom
- Increase understanding of bilingual language development
- Identify and create resources that support language development in learners of EAL
- Try out and evaluate resources with other course participants
