## Word Aware (Key Stages 1 & 2)



This licensed course focuses on developing vocabulary in primary schools. Crucial to the development of oral language, reading and writing, vocabulary teaching is often overlooked in schools. Word Aware supports teachers in selecting appropriate vocabulary, teaching it systematically and ensuring children have opportunities to activate and review new learning.

The course will cover:

- the need for a whole school approach
- implementing a structured approach to teaching vocabulary
- practical ideas to make learning new vocabulary exciting and fun
- strategies to teach children to learn words independently
- planning how to introduce and establish Word Aware in your school

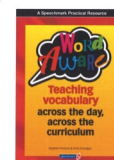
