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BILINGUALISM IN EDUCATION PROGRAMME 2020-2021

The Bilingualism in Education programme is a well-established Master's programme run in partnership between the University of Birmingham and NASSEA. It is now entering the 20th year of the partnership programme.

The programme offers:

- A structured pathway to a Master's degree in Bilingualism in Education, with exit award points at Postgraduate Certificate, Postgraduate Diploma and M.Ed. levels
- Distance learning allowing students to join the programme from anywhere in the world and to fit studies around work and home commitments
- Flexible tutoring, with face-to-face and Skype tutorial options
- Group tutorials where students can develop ideas with colleagues and their tutor
- Tutors who are specialists in English as an additional language and currently work in schools with EAL learners. Tutors have experience of working both in the UK and internationally
- The opportunity to study on a PhD or EdD programme following successful completion of the Bilingualism in Education M.Ed
- A practitioner research group for Master's graduates of the programme
- An annual conference with a free place for each student and graduating student
- University online library and resources to support distance learning
