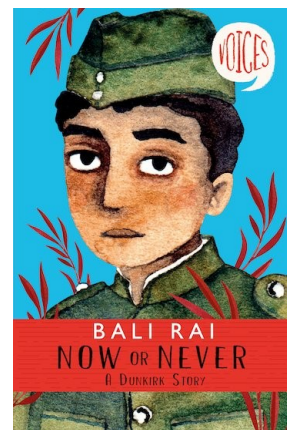
Balancing the Curriculum: History



This course aims to explore ways in which schools can deliver a balanced, diverse and modern curriculum for History that reflects and respects the histories and perspectives of BAME people. It will look at non-European ancient civilisations; significant historical figures with a BAME heritage and personal histories. It is intended for subject leaders for History and class teachers. It will introduce and remind participants of a wide range of resources to support this important area.

The course will cover:

- How to identify areas of the curriculum where a BAME viewpoint is missing.
- Identifying personal, family and community histories that provide an alternative perspective.
- Resources and activities to develop a new perspective on current curriculum content.
