## Early Years: Cultural development in the curriculum



This course aims to support the EYFS Statutory Educational Programme: Understanding the World, with a focus on fostering children's understanding of our culturally and socially diverse world.

It will:

- explore ways to help children develop positive attitudes about the differences between people;
- explore resources that reflect the diversity of life in modern Britain;
- discuss how to model the language children need to talk about themselves and ask questions about others;
- explore resources that show different countries in the world and consider how to include children's own experiences of travelling or living in different places;
- identify potential barriers to celebrating and valuing diversity in the setting.
