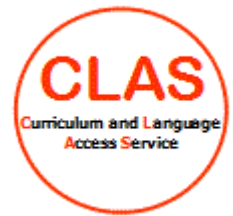

In order to support the development of their own sense of identity, children need to see themselves reflected in the stories they read and listen to. This session will look at the books we can use to do this. It is intended for teachers who lead English in their school or key stage and for class teachers and other staff who offer support to children.

Identifying texts currently read in school and how representative they are of children in Britain today.

An opportunity to reflect on our own book choices both at home and for our pupils.

Recognising and embracing the challenge of diversity education.

Examining texts that can be used to promote a wider representation of different groups.

Suggestions for alternatives to old favourites.
