A Train the Trainer course for Primary and Secondary International School teachers with experience of /responsibility for teaching bilingual learners, comprising 16 hours of taught sessions and 14 hours of self-study and classroom-based activities

The Language, Literacy and Learning Professional Learning Leader course aims to:

- Prepare experienced teachers of bilingual learners to lead this professional learning course in their school
- Develop understanding of the role of academic language & literacy in the curriculum
- Develop teachers' knowledge of how E1L and EAL /bilingual learners learn and how to use key strategies for curriculum access and language development
- Develop teachers' understanding of how to scaffold language, literacy and learning in their class or subject area to raise attainment for all pupils
- Promote cross curricular approaches to developing language, literacy and learning
- Support teachers to reflect critically on their own work and that of the school to develop effective strategies and environments for learners of all language backgrounds
